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**Facilities @ SDMCET Hostels**

✓ **Food Facility:** Food for all boy & girl inmates of the hostels is provided in the central dining hall of Santrupty building. SANTRUPTI is a TEMPLE of FOOD. Inmates have to follow all guidelines of the dining hall. Mess at Santrupty is strictly vegetarian. Quality & Verity North & South Indian style of food is served in the mess. Both boys and girls have to walk to SANTRUPTI DINING HALL for food. Every day the inmates are served breakfast between 7.15 AM & 9.15 AM, lunch between 12.30 PM & 2.30 PM, evening snacks & tea between 4.30 PM & 6.00 PM and dinner between 7.30 PM & 9.30 PM. Menu is decided by mess committee. Standard Mess Menu Calendar is given below. Every Saturday, special menu is prepared for lunch and mess will be closed in the evening to enable the students to eat food of their choice in hotels in the city. Around 90 workers ably carryout mess activities under the supervision of mess managers. Mess charges and electricity charges are levied to each inmate on dividing basis. Mess leave facility is granted only if the inmate is hospitalised for health reasons or represents our college in technical, sports & cultural competitions, or any justifiable domestic reasons in the family of inmate. **MESS MENU CALENDER FOR A MONTH**

**Note:**

1. Seasonal fruits will be provided as per the menu list based on availability and cost.

2. Boiled water will be provided during food timings on all days.
3. Sweets will be provided during National Holidays and Festival days.
4. Soups will be given occasionally.
5. Bournvita, AmvE rich (Ayurvedic drink) will be provided on few days of the month along with night milk.
6. Menu is subject to availability of vegetables. May change occasionally.
7. On Saturdays, after lunch, mess will close. Inmates will have to go outside for tea and dinner.
8. Inmates should wear full dress & switch off their mobile, use minimum time for dining in the mess and contribute for smooth functioning of mess.

- ✓ **Round the clock electricity and water:** The college has 3 D-G sets, two D-G sets of 250 kVA & one of 125 kVA capacity and four bore wells to ensure uninterrupted supply of power and water. Water purifiers and coolers provided in each floor of every hostel, guarantee softened, purified, warm / cold safe drinking water to inmates. Three pollution free diesel fired hot water boilers supply hot water for bathing twice a day (morning & evening at scheduled timings).
- ✓ **Health care:** Group insurance cover & health cards are provided to all inmates at college level. Round the clock, emergency vehicle service is provided, to shift and treat the inmates at SDM Medical Hospital which is one of the finest hospitals in the region. A health care centre also works in the campus.
- ✓ **Sri. Ganesha Temple & Meditation Hall:** Newly built temple will be open for hostel inmates all the time.
- ✓ **Security:** Round the clock security is provided at all the hostels. Guards with walkie-talkie monitor the hostels. Entry of outsiders and unauthorised persons are restricted in the hostels.
- ✓ **Sports:** The college ground is in front of the boy's hostels & Santruption building. Inmates can play indoor games like chess, carom, table tennis & palm tennis and outdoor sport provided. Sports competition is conducted among hostel inmates and winners will be awarded prizes on Hostel Day Celebrations.

- ✓ **Multi-gym:** Well equipped multi-gym facility is provided separately for boys in the Santrupty building & for girls in the Sharavati Hostel.
- ✓ **Guest Rooms:** Guest rooms with attached bathroom and AC / non-AC facility are available in the Alumni Association Building in the campus near hostels. The parents of the inmates can avail this facility by booking in advance depending on their availability and on payment basis, whenever they come for meeting their wards.
- ✓ **Internet/Wi-Fi:** The campus is provided with high speed internet / Wi-Fi connectivity and is accessible round the clock. The inmates can carryout their computer based assignments and term works from their rooms.
- ✓ **Recreational Facilities:** Facilities like TV, daily & weekly news periodicals are provided in the recreational hall of Santrupty building for both boys & girls & also only for girls in Girls hostels. An exclusive music club also is in the campus.
- ✓ **Multi-facility complex:** A multi-facility complex near hostels provides facilities like Laundry, Hair dressing saloon, Ice cream & Fruit juice centre, Stationary shop Fast food etc., to inmates.
- ✓ **Beauty Parlour:** A Beauty Parlour functions in Hemavati Hostel exclusively for the girl inmates of our hostels. Minor cloth / dress alteration needs are also fulfilled there.
- ✓ **ATM Facility:** Karnataka Bank ATM works round the clock in the campus.
- ✓ **Other Facilities in the College Campus:**  
Other facilities like, Karnataka Bank Extension Counter, a Xerox Centre, a coffee shop, a Bakery, a Post office, a Co-operative Stores, a fast food centre, also functions in the campus for the basic needs of the hostel / college students.

### **Special Measures/Activities:**

- Ø First year inmates are cared extra till they adjust to the college environment. Special anti-ragging measures as per Supreme Court of India directions are taken to prevent ragging.

- Ø Motored two wheelers are discouraged on campus. Wearing helmet is mandatory for all students including hostel inmates while driving on two wheelers in the campus.
- Ø As an outing for hostel inmates, college buses ply between hostels and nearby scenic spot & Sri Hanuman Temple every Saturday evening. Also, on that day buses ply to city to facilitate inmates for shopping and dinner.
- Ø SDMCET hostels observe festivals such as Sri Ganesh, Dasserah Deepavali and Holi. On these days, special menu is provided for inmates.

### **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

- § Obtain the hostel admission application form from the Xerox centre in the college campus.
- § Fill up all the details in it, fix a stamp size photograph and return to the hostel office.
- § Admission is subject to the following rules and regulations.

### **Rules and Regulations governing admission to SDMCET Hostels**

- ✚ Application for admission to hostel must be made in the prescribed form along with the undertaking letter & provisional grade card of latest examination. Incomplete applications, applications with wrong information and without undertakings by student and parents will not be entertained.
- ✚ Admission to hostels is subject to availability of vacancy in the rooms. First 250 students who get admitted to first year & want hostel are guaranteed admission.
- ✚ Admission from 2<sup>nd</sup> year onwards is based on merit & behaviour of students in their previous years stay in the hostel.
- ✚ Admission to hostel is considered only after the student takes admission to a study program in the college.
- ✚ The student's preferred accommodation is provided purely on merit of his / her previous declared examination result.
- ✚ Admission will be for both stay and boarding compulsorily.
- ✚ Admission will be granted only after the student pays all the prescribed fees and dues of previous year. All the hostel fees have to be paid in single instalment during the time of admission only.
- ✚ Room once allotted is final and will not be changed for any reasons.
- ✚ Once admitted, the student will not be allowed to vacate without the written permission of his parent.
- ✚ Student having negative remarks during his / her previous stay is liable for denial of hostel admission.
- ✚ Students failing to maintain minimum prescribed attendance will be expelled from the hostel with information to his / her parents.
- ✚ Admission given is only for 10 academic months. Students have to compulsorily vacate the hostel within 4 days of completion of his / her last even semester.

examination. For stay beyond, the student has to pay extra rent as decided by hostel authorities.

## **DISCIPLINE**

Discipline in the hostel will be under the control of the Chief Warden, Resident Wardens. Students are expected to maintain discipline and proper atmosphere of study in the hostels.

1. Following acts of indiscipline are strictly prohibited in the hostel premises.
  - Ragging in any form.
  - Smoking, drinking liquor, gambling, chewing of gutka, use of drugs & narcotics and other toxic substance of any kind.
  - Possession / carrying of lethal weapons like guns, revolver, rods or any other gadget that can be used as weapon.
  - Fighting, abusing using foul languages / un-parliamentary words.
  - Unnecessary movement or playing of games in the corridors and quadrangles.
  - Shouting, hooting, whistling or otherwise causing disturbance to other inmates in the hostel.
  - Entry of female visitors into the rooms of the inmates in Boy's Hostel and male visitors into the rooms of Girl's Hostel without written permission.
  - Any type of markings on hostel inventory / walls, writing on walls / doors, spitting etc.
  - Display of any notice / circular / poster / banner in the hostel premises without the prior permission of the Chief Warden.
  - Meetings, gatherings without prior permission of the Warden.
  - Any political activity in the hostel premises.
  - Damaging, misusing and stealing of the any hostel properties or stealing others belongings.
  - Leaving their room with the lights and fans on.
  - Cooking inside the room without prior permission.
  - Any kind of acts of vandalism in hostel or on campus.
  - Inmates staying outside overnight without prior permission from the Resident Warden.
  - Entry and hosting of outsiders in the hostel without permission of the Resident Warden.
  - Absence of inmates from the hostel after the stipulated time as fixed by the authority.
  - Playing of audio and visual systems and other musical instrument / systems inside the room or in the hostel premises causing disturbance to other inmates and neighbours.
  - Dance parties in the hostel.

- Objectionable way of birthday celebrations.
  - Carrying and eating of non-vegetarian items in the hostels.
2. Acts of misbehaviour, misconduct, indiscipline or violation of the Rules, Regulations & Discipline mentioned above are liable for one or more punishments as stated below.
    - Warning to the student.
    - Warning to the student as well as letter to the parents.
    - Imposition of a fine.
    - Refusal of admission in the next term or academic year.
    - Rustication.
    - Expulsion from the hostel / college.
  3. In case of severe disciplinary action against a student, any other punishment as decided by competent authorities, physical presence / undertaking of parents only will be considered as valid. The Chief Warden is vested with full powers to recommend expulsion of a student from the hostel without assigning any reason if his / her presence is considered detrimental to the discipline of the hostel and the decision will be final and binding on the student.
  4. Chief Warden / Resident Wardens or any other Hostel Authority can inspect any room at any time.
  5. The names of hostel inmates, who are absent themselves for 10 consecutive days without prior permission, will be struck off.
  6. Entry in the hostel will not be allowed beyond 10:30 PM in case of Boys Hostels and beyond 9:30 PM in case of Girls Hostels.
  7. Day scholars, friends, Parents / Guests are not permitted to stay in the hostel without prior permission of Chief Warden / Resident Warden.
  8. The students shall be responsible for the college property issued or provided in the hostel. Damage of any hostel property shall be recovered from the concerned resident, along with a penalty.
  9. The inmates are allowed to leave the campus after making the necessary entry in movement register available in respective hostel with security guard.

## General

- Every inmate must acquaint himself / herself with the rules and regulations of the hostel. He / she must obey these rules strictly. Ignorance of rules will not be accepted as an excuse.
- Each inmate should see that the room occupied by her / him is kept neat and clean.
- Strict silence should be observed in the hostel to facilitate studying.
- If an inmate is ill, the same should be reported to the Resident Warden, who will then make suitable arrangements to take care of that inmate and provide medical attention.

- Any one falling sick is advised to make use of SDM Hospital facilities and also inform the Resident Warden. Residents resorting to treatment elsewhere without the knowledge of the Resident Warden do so at their own risk.
- Students are advised not to keep valuables / cash, Laptop, Calculator, Mobile phones, as they are prone to theft. Due care must be exercised by the inmates in their room. The hostel authorities cannot be held responsible for any loss or theft of their belongings. The residents must make their own arrangements for safe custody of the valuables.
- Movement of hostel property (bed, chairs etc.) from one room to another is not allowed.
- The students can keep PC in hostel rooms with due permission from Chief Warden / Resident Warden.
- Students are hereby instructed not to go for late night excursions. This amounts to physical as well as legal risk to be away from the campus (with or without vehicles).
- Complaint Register kept in the hostel office be used for giving complaints on hygiene, repairs etc.
- The Rules and Regulations are subject to amendments and wherever amended, will have immediate effect and be a binding on all inmates.
- Any matter not covered by the above rules shall be decided by the Chief Warden with the consent by the Rector.
